



LASER GAME - VISIT REGULATION

1. INITIAL PROVISION

- The founder and operator of the Laser Game Arena is CENTRUM BABYLON, a. s., Nitranska 1, 460 07 Liberec III - Jerab.
- The premises of the Arena are intended for the operation of the Laser Game.
- The premises are part of the Bowling operation, where the ticket office is located. The Laser Game consists of an entrance hall, an equipment area and a game area called the Arena.
- The Arena can be used by individuals or groups.
- Entry to the Arena is strictly at your own risk, acknowledging that increased physical activity under significantly reduced visibility conditions takes place there. Children and minors (under the age of 12) are only allowed in the Arena when supervised by a person over the age of 18.
- Users of the Arena, referred to as players, are obliged to observe the pre-arranged time limit and to play the Laser Game in the game area only. They are also obliged to observe the rules of safety and property protection at all times. In addition, they are required to observe the instructions of the Arena operators or other authorised persons.
- For the protection of persons and property, the equipment area (vests and weapons) and the entrance to the Arena are monitored by a camera system with a recording function, with recordings being stored for the period of time deemed necessary for dealing with offences, theft and damage etc. Any persons entering this area agree to be monitored by the CCTV system.
- The Visitor Regulations apply to the entire Laser Game Arena area and the user is obliged to comply with them.

2. OPERATIONS AND MANAGEMENT OF THE LASER GAME AND THE ARENA AREA

- The operator is responsible for smooth operation. The game can be booked by phone - +420 485 249 309 - or by e-mail at zabava@centrumbabylon.cz.
- Tickets can be purchased at the ticket office of the Bowling operation, where they are also to be submitted, or from the e-shop of CENTRUM BABYLON, a.s. only.
- The premises are open all year round according to the operating hours indicated at the entrance to the Bowling alley and on the website. Exceptions to the operating hours are always indicated in advance on the website.
- The premises may be used outside of the stated operating hours by prior arrangement.

3. SAFETY AND PROTECTION OF PROPERTY

- For safety reasons, only players are allowed to enter the Arena.
- Each player is obliged to act in such a way so as not to put the life, health, property, rights or legitimate interests of themselves or any other persons at risk. At the same time, each player agrees to observe the rules of courteous and decent behaviour, public order and ethics, and not to disturb or harass other players. Players are obliged to keep the Laser Game Arena area clean and to follow the instructions of the staff and other authorized persons.
- The following is prohibited in the Arena:
 - Entering in inappropriate footwear (high-heel shoes, dirty shoes, etc.). Appropriate footwear is closed-toe sports shoes.
 - Physical contact between players.
 - Entering areas that are cordoned off and used for decoration only.
 - Climbing walls to inaccessible heights.
 - Bringing in or handling sharp or otherwise dangerous objects (e.g. knives, scissors, glass bottles, etc.).
 - Moving or handling objects in the Arena.
 - Entering with and consuming drinks or food.
 - Entering with chewing gum and disposal thereof.
 - Entry by intoxicated persons.
 - Smoking anywhere within the Laser Game Arena.
 - Wearing the vest on a naked body.
- Players must report any defects found in the Arena or on the equipment to the staff immediately.
- Any injury must be reported to the operator immediately, including the details as to how the injury occurred
- The Operator or other authorised person reserves the right to order out of the Arena persons who do not comply with the rules set out in these Visitor Regulations at any time (including in the case of unfinished play) and without compensation. This is without prejudice to the right of the Operator to claim compensation for damages.
- Each player enters the Arena at their own risk.

4. FINAL PROVISIONS

- By entering the game area, the player confirms that they have been informed of the rules of the Laser Game and, in particular, the rules of safety, and accept these rules without reservation.
